



## White Deer Park and Nature Center Group Outing Tips

Helpful information for making your visit to White Deer Park a success:

- ✂ Just bringing a group out to play and enjoy the park? Call us before you come! Your call is not a reservation but allows us to better prepare for your visit. (Our phone number is 919.661.6982.) If you are interested in scheduling a program or reserving a picnic shelter, please read the 'Educational Programs' page for more information.
- ✂ Please only park in the paved parking areas. If bringing a bus, drivers may drop off passengers on the west side of the park. Buses will be directed to park on the east side of the park or possibly across the street at Lake Benson Park, depending on availability that day. (See attached map for parking areas.)
- ✂ Group tours of the park must be scheduled in advance. There is no charge for general tours; however, these tours are dependent upon staff availability. Please call 919.661.6982 to speak with a staff member in regards to scheduling.
- ✂ Educational programs may be scheduled up to 6 months in advance but no less than 3 weeks in advance. Please read our 'Educational Programs' page for more information.
- ✂ Picnic shelters can be reserved up to 90 days in advance. Each shelter has a grill and capacity for approximately 50 people. The fee is \$20 per hour/2 hour minimum. If you are scheduling a program with park staff, please inquire about special package prices.
- ✂ White Deer Park recycles! Please separate trash from recyclable materials and place in the appropriate containers located around the park.

### White Deer Park Rules:

- Park hours: sunrise to sunset
- No alcohol, weapons, or fireworks allowed on park property
- No open fires: grill only in designated areas
- No unauthorized motorized vehicles on trails
- Pets must be kept on leashes at all times
- Pet owners must clean up pet waste
- Stay on designated trails for your safety and the protection of plants and animals
- Do not pick, remove or disturb plants or wildlife in the park
- Littering is illegal: dispose of trash in the appropriate containers
- Please dispose of recycling in the appropriate containers
