Re: South Garner Greenway Extension - Buffaloe Road Alignment Update

At the September 26, 2023 Work Session, the design team from Withers Ravenel will present the 30% schematic design plans for the Buffaloe Road Alignment of the South Garner Greenway Extension. This greenway project is funded through the 2021 Park Bond.

In their presentation, the Withers Ravenel team will provide details on the alignment, potential right-of-way or easement needs, the route through the Lake Benson Boathouse site, and options for the bridge crossing Lake Benson.

Project History

- 2019 Feasibility study completed by the John R. McAdams Company that identified three potential routes for this greenway corridor
- 2021 Project identified as a priority for the 2021 Park Bond
- June 2022 Town contracts McAdams to revise and update the feasibility study focusing on the Buffaloe Road options
- October 25, 2022 Town Council approves the southside of Buffaloe Road as the preferred route and directs staff to continue the design process
- December 20, 2022 Town Council approves contract with Withers Ravenel for design services
- September 12, 2023 Community Meeting Held at the White Deer Nature Center to gather feedback from neighbors and community members. More than 60 people were in attendance.
- September 19, 2023 Presentation to the Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Advisory Committee
