Recommended Budget - \$74.5M

- A proposed 52-cent tax rate per \$100 in valuation
- The Recommended tax rate includes:
 - 43.5¢ Town operations
 - 8.5¢ for the Revenue Savings
 Plan
- 8.5 cent tax increase above revenue neutral rate of 43.5 cents

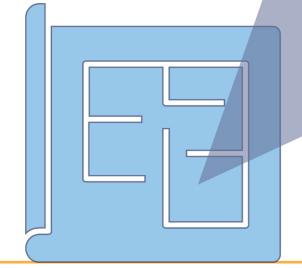

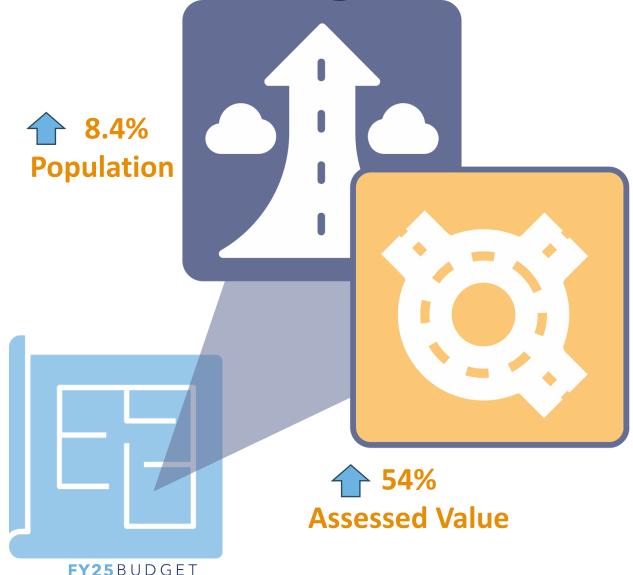
