C. Major Subdivision Plan Request:

Staff Overview:

SB-17-04, The Bluffs at Heather Park – S. Wake Properties is requesting subdivision approval for an 11-lot multi-family residential homes. The site is located at 201 Southerby Bluffs Court and can be further identified as Wake County PINs **1710-56-4820** and **1710-56-4654**.

RESULT:

CONFIRMED CONFORMITY [UNANIMOUS] - Commission confirmed staff's findings in Section IV of this report that SB-17-04, The Bluffs at Heather Park is in conformity with adopted town plans and policies and stands approved so long as the following conditions of approval are met:

- 2. A Homeowner's Association shall be created with restrictive covenants submitted to the Planning Director for review and recorded in conjunction with the first final plat.
